

Pitt H. Herbert, 80, lens designer with Bausch & Lomb Optical Co. from 1924 until his retirement in 1949, died at Genesee Hospital, Rochester, N. Y., Feb. 8.

Funeral services were held in Southbridge, Mass. Mr. Herbert was a native of that city and had been employed by American Optical Co. for 25 years before going to Rochester.

Mr. Herbert was also known for his spectacle collections. His displays have been exhibited at the Smithsonian Institute in Washington, D. C., and at the Rochester Museum of Arts and Sciences.

His son and four grandchildren survive.
